	Program description	The clinic offers biopsychosocial assessments of complex persistent pain and an interdisciplinary ACT/CBT-based program for children after referral from primary or specialized care.  The first visit is an interdisciplinary assessment of medical history, comorbidities, pain characteristics and impairments, supplemented with self-report questionnaires of QoL and functioning. The assessment results in recommendations of treatment at the clinic, advice back to the referring doctor or referral to pediatric psychiatry.  Treatment is manual-based, but individually tailored, and primarily offered as individual out-patient, weekly day care visits and performed interdisciplinary over 3 - 5 months. More intensive treatment is offered for long distance families or children in need of intense exposure e.g., CRPS.
