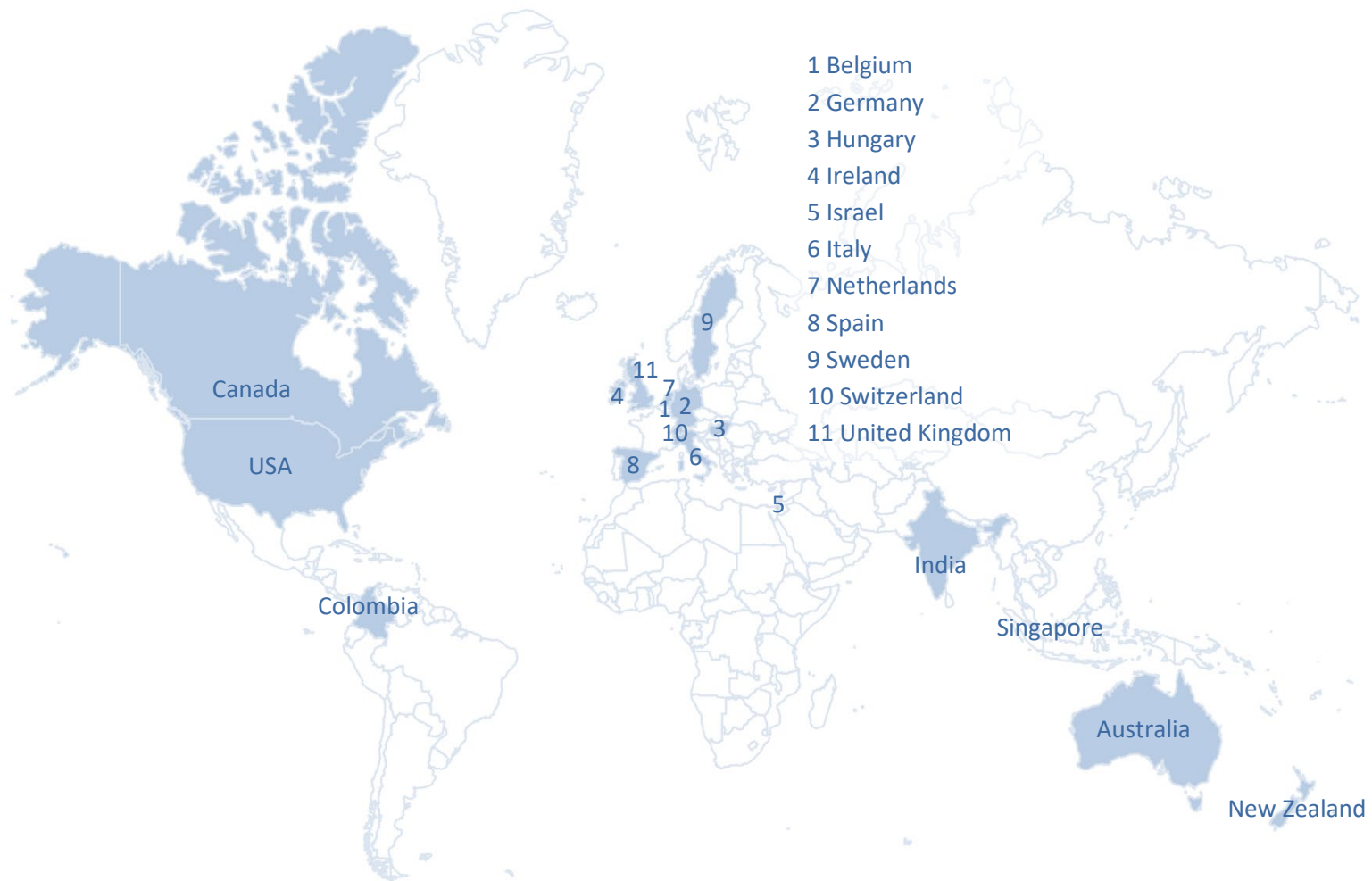

	Program description	Referrals are accepted from general practitioners or specialists involved in ongoing care of the young person. Children and young people must be aged 0-16 years at time of referral, but care may continue up to 19 years of age. Prioritisation is based on pain-related impacts on sleep, mobility, learning participation, relationships and mood. Children who are Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander people, refugees and/or in out of home care are prioritised. Service clinicians may support primary health clinicians caring for the child with interim advice whilst awaiting assessment. Patients are assessed by the interdisciplinary team in a combined session(s), followed by individualized interdisciplinary pain management (integrated therapy tailoring pharmacological, physiotherapy, psychological therapies and social support to child and family needs)

	Program description	Complex and intractable pain is managed through an out-patient interdisciplinary (medical, nursing, psychology, physiotherapy) consultative service, a moderate intensity day program (T.A.M.E. Your Pain), a Tele-health service, and an inpatient medical and nursing consultative service. The service receives state-wide referrals from general practice and specialists. Inpatient admission occurs under the care of the primary team caring for the child with consultation from medical and nursing pain clinic staff.

	Program description	The South Australian Paediatric Chronic Pain Service comprises an interdisciplinary team of medical and allied health practitioners. They offer coordinated outpatient and community management for children and young people dealing with chronic pain. The team collaborates closely with each child and their family to develop a personalized pain management plan. Additionally, they facilitate communication and coordination among the family, caregivers, hospital, and community-based health services. The team conducts a group educational program called, "The Comfortability Program" for parents and young individuals. This program is supplemented with follow-up rehabilitation sessions aimed at empowering patients and their families to actively participate in their own care to the fullest extent possible. The progress of each patient is closely monitored, with the ultimate goal of enabling each child to achieve their optimal level of functionality and ensuring their care is transitioned to local community services.

	Program description	The Complex Pain service operates within the Perth Children's' Hospital as an outpatient service. We accept referrals from the medical and surgical teams at PCH for patients ranging from birth to 16 years of age. These young patients and families can be referred to our service as part of a collaborative and interdisciplinary approach to their rehabilitation journey. When children endure persistent, unresolved pain, it often impacts their physical, social, and emotional well-being. A cornerstone of our service is a comprehensive Interdisciplinary Team Assessment (IDT) by medical specialists and allied health teams focused on gaining an in-depth understanding of the unique health journey of each child and their family. The Interdisciplinary approach to assessment helps us to understand how pain is impacting each family, enabling an individualised management plan that takes into account a bio-psychosocial understanding of pain, relationships, function, and their combined influence on overall well-being. We work closely with the Department of Education and have a teacher embedded in our clinical team to support young people transitioning back to full time school.

We provide patients and families with tools to take control over the pain and cope with it.</p> <p>We offer a tailored approach combining pharmacological, physical, psychological and integrative therapies. We refer to external networks. We offer a follow-up adapted to the individual needs.</p>

The clinics are multidisciplinary, or have access to a multidisciplinary team and all focus on the biopsychosocial model of care. All the clinics can refer to The Comfort Ability program. The IPRP has a partnership with the Calgary Board of Education where the youth are able to receive high school credits while completing their educational pain/therapeutic work in the program.

	Program description	Our interdisciplinary complex pain team assists patients and families with the management of pain while seeking to optimize physical, psychological, sleep, and social function. At the first visit, the patient will undergo individualized sensory testing before meeting with our team for a physical and psychosocial assessment. By the end of that visit, our goal is to elaborate a personalized treatment plan that we communicate on the spot to patients and families, providing a road map toward optimized functioning. We follow up our patients every 2-3 months in clinic, while our psychoeducator, social worker, physiotherapist, and nurses work with the patients and parents between clinic visits. We are involved in educational activities around complex pain for primary care practitioners in Quebec. Finally, we are continually analyzing outcomes and sharing with the broader clinical and research community to ensure that we are providing evidence-informed, people- and family-centered care to all of our patients.

	Program description	<p>The MiPAIN (Michigan Pediatric Adolescent Interdisciplinary Network) is a comprehensive pain program housed within the University of Michigan's CS Mott Children's Hospital. The program is designed to meet the needs of pediatric and adolescent patients with ongoing pain and their caregivers. Our overarching goal is to educate individuals and their caretakers about the nature of pain, why it arises within an individual and most importantly how they can live full and enriching lives while effectively managing their pain and reducing its impact. Examples of what we hope participants in our program accomplish include being fully engaged in developmentally appropriate activities like academic pursuits, return to sports and leisure activities, we hope they remain socially engaged with friends and peers and improve their participation in family responsibilities. Our partnership with patients begins with a thorough review of medical records, review of patient-centered questionnaires and a combination of face-to-face and virtual evaluations with patients and their families to arrive at an accurate diagnosis and comprehensive tailored treatment plan. To facilitate individuals to get back to living, we offer psychotherapy, physical therapy, occupational therapy, recreation therapy, art therapy, medication management and interventional strategies when needed. While our treatment approach is tailored to individual patient and family need, we consistently offer three tiers of intervention with increasing levels of intensity. The first tier includes individual therapies like psychology, physical or occupational therapy or medication management. Our paired model of care is a combination of physical or occupational therapy and psychotherapy aimed at facilitating recovery from pain-related disability and return to active and fulfilling lifestyles through experiential learning. This allows participants to actively apply physical therapy and psychological principles to their daily life in sustained, but brief episodes of care. Finally, we offer a multi-week intensive outpatient program (IOP) in which participants (both patient and families) work with psychologists, physical therapists, occupational therapists, physical medicine and rehabilitation physicians, an art therapist and recreational therapist in both individual and group settings. This program, while intense is designed to help ready participants "jump start" their coping with chronic pain, learn new coping strategies to deal effectively with their pain in a safe and supportive environment. Participants and their families learn from each other and their therapists through individual and group models of care. Finally, we take advantage of the vibrant academic focus of the University of Michigan campus by training the next generation of pain providers including psychology, medical residents and pain fellows. It is within this environment that we also conduct active lines of research identifying fundamental mechanisms of pediatric chronic pain, refining patient reported outcomes and measuring pain treatment effectiveness.</p>
